Ellen White wrote on March 3rd 1899 to brother and sister Haskell. The content of which was later published in their church bulletin.

She wrote of the time she stood up to speak on Sabbath morning. On that occasion She presented her burden for the reception of the Holy Spirit.

"The whole subject was the opening of our hearts to the Holy Spirit. I was trying to present to those who were there the great necessity of receiving the Spirit. Christ told the disciples. 'I have many things to say unto you, but ye can not bear them now.' Their (deciples) own limited comprehension put a restraint upon Him, so that he could not open to them the things he longed to unfold; for it would be labour lost."

This is an encouraging reason for us all to seriously consider meeting together for prayer.

Things that cannot be explained will happen when we allow God into our lives.
