

Can You Help Please

Some years ago Tony Welch went as a co-driver with Mike Thompson and Ruth Farrar to Romania to take aid to a number of orphanages run by female ministers of religion. Whilst in Romania, Tony was taken to meet a very poor Adventist family who lived just out side Targu Mures, the third largest city in Romania. The father suffered from an inherited severe kidney problem. His parents and sister have all died of it and he has to spend considerable lengths of time in Hospital. They have adopted three children rather than risk passing the problem on to any descendents of their own. They were living in a small house that did not provide for his needs. At the time Tony was there plans were being made to build a purpose built home on some of their nearby farmland. After a number of years the new house has finally been completed, only to find that the electricity company now want £1,500 to connect up to the mains supply - even though there is a supply point nearby.

Tony would like to raise this money so that he can take it with him when he next leaves for Romania on Tuesday 10th October.
