

The NEC Camp meeting this year is from 25th June to 1st July. If you wish to book please see John Lewis who has the necessary booking forms


Ingathering ADRA

Passover (14th Nican) this year was yesterday (Friday). Did you know that Easter this year falls on exactly the same days as it did in 31 AD? - This was the year Jesus died on the cross.

At 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon Jesus died on the cross. Jesus then rested in the tomb throughout the whole 24 hours of the Sabbath and rose again on the first day of the week, which was Sunday.

The resurrection Sunday (16th Nican) was much more than the first day of the week. This was the day that marked the anniversary of the first of the barley harvest, when the manna stopped for the first time in 40 years (See Joshua 5:10-12).

For the first time in 40 years Israel ate food they had grown for themselves. The first barley sheaf was the first fruit of the year and the assurance that the wheat and fruit harvest would follow in due course.

When Jesus rose from the grave, He rose up out of the ground and became the 'first fruits' of all who are in the grave.

The Bible teaches that Jesus was the "first fruit" of those who have died and await the resurrection (Read 1 Corinthians 15:20-23).

What amazes me about all this is that Jesus came exactly on time. He fulfilled everything that He came to do, exactly on time. Surely this is enough evidence to trust the Bible completely.
