What's The Point of Reporting?

Mark 6:7 Jesus sends out the twelve, two by two, and gave them authority over evil spirits.

Mark 6:12,13 The disciples went out and preached repentance, drove out demons, anointed the sick with oil and healed them.

Mark 6:30 “The apostles gathered around Jesus and reported to him all they had done and taught”

The late Reverend Donald English In his book “The Message of Mark”. Comments on: ***‘how little Mark makes of this first excursion into ministry by the apostles. It is almost as though more important than what they had done is their coming back to report it’.***

As important as our preaching, teaching, healing and casting out demons may be; the reporting of these activities is also important.

This sets us a precedent, to all our activities within a church context. From visiting to making phone calls; from transportation to shopping; from help given practically to Bible study. Whatever we do, the reporting of the deed is important for the church.

Just as the disciples returned and reported what they had done and then waited on Jesus to give them their next commands.

So our reporting is to wait on Him for our next set of instructions. **‘These are the things that are the fruits of true discipleship but they are not its root. The root is attachment to Jesus himself, from whom the disciples’ life comes.’**
