Resolving the "character" issue

See Wednesday's section for this week's lesson. "Jesus is the forerunner, having entered as our Representative into the heavenly sanctuary, even into the very presence of God for us. That is, Jesus is standing before the Father, ministering the merits of His atonement, the "eternal redemption" that He "obtained" in our behalf".

"Yes, when we accepted Jesus our sins were forgiven, and we stood before God pardoned and cleansed. 
