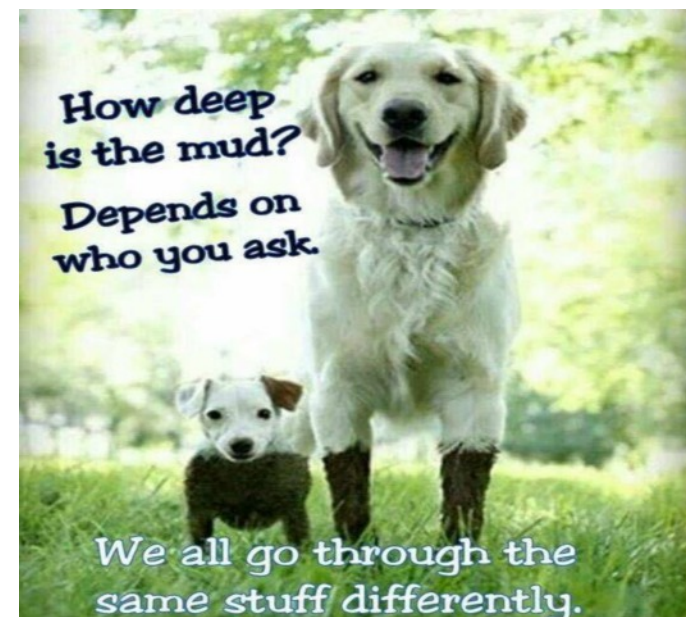
Diary of Events
