Becomes a Federal matter now.

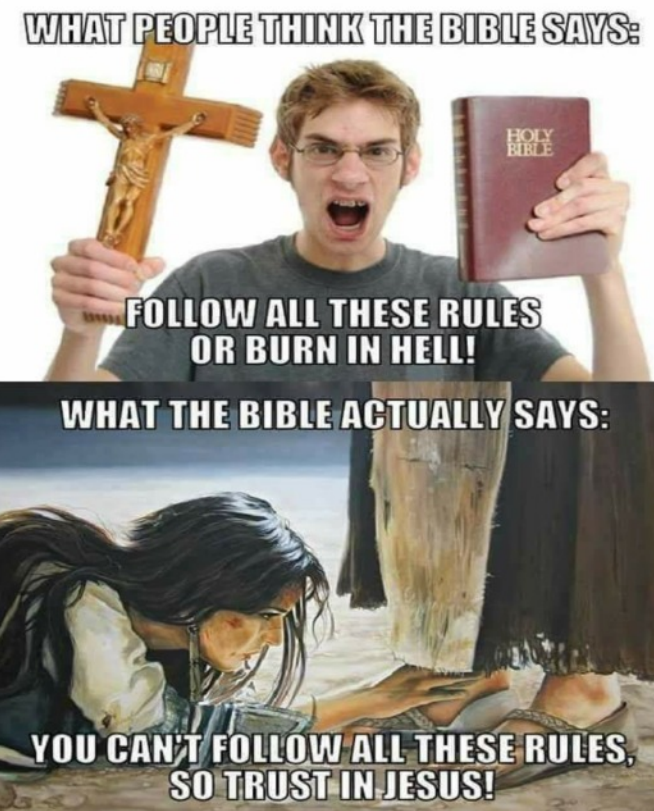
Our hair can be purple, orange and green,
