

## “Acts of the Apostle”

**The quotation that follows surprised me. Wow!**

“Christ's ascension to heaven was the signal that His followers were to receive the promised blessing. For this they were to wait before they entered upon their work. When Christ passed within the heavenly gates, He was **enthroned** amidst the adoration of the angels. As soon as this ceremony was completed, the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples in rich currents, and Christ was indeed glorified, even with the glory which He had with the Father from all eternity. The Pentecostal outpouring was Heaven's communication that the Redeemer's **inauguration** was accomplished. According to His promise He had sent the Holy Spirit from heaven to His followers as a token that He had, as **priest and king**, received all authority in heaven and on earth, and was the Anointed One over His people”. The above quote from “Acts of the Apostles” came as a big surprise to me. For years I have thought of Revelation 4 and 5 as chapters describing the temple in Heaven with Jesus receiving the authority to begin work as Priest and High Priest.
