The Ten Longest Wars in History

1. THE VIETNAM WAR. Length: 19 years (1955–1975). Estimated deaths: 2.4 million
2. THE GREAT NORTHERN WAR. Length: 21 years (1700–1721). Estimated deaths: more than 300,000.
3. FIRST PUNIC WAR. Length: 23 years (264–241 BC). Estimated deaths: Around 250,000
4. THE CHINESE WAR. Length: 31 years (1873–1904). Estimated deaths: 90,000
5. THE PELOPONNESIAN WAR. Length: 27 years (431–404 BC). Estimated deaths: Unknown
6. THE WARS OF THE ROSES. Length: 30 years (1455–1485). Estimated deaths: Around 100,000
7. THE THIRTY YEARS’ WAR. Length: 30 years (1618–1648). Estimated deaths: 8 million
8. THE GUATEMALAN CIVIL WAR. Length: 36 years (1960–1996). Estimated deaths: 200,000
9. THE GRECO-PERSIAN WARS. Length: 38 years (between 499–449 BC). Estimated deaths: Unknown
10. THE HUNDRED YEARS’ WAR. Length: 116 years (1337–1453). Estimated deaths: Possibly as high as 3.5 million
