This provision applies to parents/carers and their children/immediate dependants and does not apply to family groups comprising extended family members or friends • Chalet Ticket: £700 all inclusive - There will be three chalets available for campers to book during Family Camp 2019. Chalets are allocated with preference given to those who have least recently booked a chalet with consideration given to special needs and medical requirements • Camp Tents: No extra charge. • Camp pods will be charged £100 in addition to the booking fees mentioned above • Own tent or caravans: No extra charge. • A 20% discount will be granted to all individuals attending Aberdaron Family Camp for the first time.

I am happy to inform you that Kettering Children Sabbath School and Pathfinder/Adventurers Club will be supporting the above named Foodbank in March 2019.

Every day people in the UK go hungry for many reasons, but just a small box of food can make a big difference. Foodbanks provide emergency food to people in crisis and their need is increasingly important. Northampton SDA Church Distribution Centre Foodbank is part of The Re: Store Northampton a charity run by central vineyard church and supported by local people, to serve those in need within the town.
